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INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT ON CONSOLIDATED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

To the Members of RUNGTA MOULDINGS PRIVATE LIMITED

Report on the Audit of the Consolidated Financial Statements

We have audited the accompanying Consolidated financial statements of **RUNGTA MOULDINGS PRIVATE LIMITED** ("the company") (herein referred to as "the Investor/Holding Company"), its subsidiaries (the Holding Company and its subsidiaries together referred to as "the Group") which comprise the Consolidated Balance Sheet as at 30th September 2023, the Consolidated Statement of Profit and Loss and the Consolidated cash flow statement for the half year ended 30th September, 2023, and notes to the consolidated financial statements including a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information (hereinafter referred to as "the consolidated financial statements").

NOTES FORMING PART OF CONSOLIDATED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

1. Basis of Consolidation & Significant Accounting Policies

(I) Basis of Consolidation:

The consolidated financial statements relate to Rungta Mouldings Private Limited (the Company) and its subsidiary companies. The Company and its subsidiaries constitute the Group.

a.) Basis of Preparation

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles in India to comply with the Accounting Standards specified under Section 133 of Companies Act, 2013, read with Rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014 and the relevant provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the 2013 Act") / Companies Act, 1956 ("the 1956 Act"), as applicable.

b.) Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements requires management to make judgments, estimates and assumptions, that affect the application of accounting policies and the reported amounts of assets, liabilities, income, expenses and disclosures of contingent liabilities at the date of these financial statements. Actual results may differ from these estimates. Estimates and underlying assumptions are reviewed at each balance sheet date. Revisions to accounting estimates are recognised in the period in which the estimate is revised and future periods affected.

c.) Principles of Consolidation

The consolidated financial statements have been prepared on the following basis:

- i. The financial statements of the subsidiary companies used in the consolidation are drawn upto the same reporting date as of the Company i.e. period ended September 30, 2023.
- ii. The financial statements of the Company and its subsidiary companies have been combined on a line-by-line basis by adding together like items of assets, liabilities, income and expenses. The intra-group balances and intra-group transactions and unrealised profits have been fully eliminated.
- iii. The excess of cost to the Company of its investments in the subsidiary companies over its share of equity of the subsidiary companies, at the dates on which the investments in the subsidiary companies are made, is recognised as 'Goodwill' being an asset in the consolidated financial statements. Alternatively, where the share of equity in the subsidiary companies as on the date of investment is in excess of cost of investment of the Company, it is recognised as 'Capital Reserve' and shown under the head 'Reserves and Surplus', in the consolidated financial statements.
- iv. Minority interest in the net assets of consolidated subsidiaries consists of the amount of equity attributable to the minority shareholders at the dates on which investments are made by the Company in the subsidiary companies and further movements in their share in the equity, subsequent to the dates of investments as stated above.

(II) SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1. Basis of Preparation of Financial Statements

These financial statements have been prepared to comply with the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles in India (Indian GAAP), including the Accounting Standards notified under the relevant provisions of the Companies Act, 2013. The financial statements are prepared on accrual basis under the historical cost convention.

2. Revenue Recognition

All revenue and expenses are accounted for on accrual basis. Revenue is recognized when no significant uncertainties exist in relation to the amount of eventual receipts.

Excise Duty/Service Tax

Excise duty / Service tax is accounted on the basis of both, payments made in respect of goods cleared / services provided in the nature of transportation charges and provisions made for goods lying in factory premises.

3. Use of estimates

The preparation of financial statements requires the management of the company to make estimates and assumption that affect the reported balances of assets and liabilities and disclosures relating to contingent liabilities as at the date of the financial statements and the reported amount of revenues and expenses during the year. Difference between the actual results and estimates are recognized in the period in which the results are known/ materialized.

4. Fixed Assets

Tangible Assets are stated at cost net of recoverable taxes, trade discounts and rebates and include amounts added on revaluation, less accumulated depreciation and impairment loss, if any. The cost of Tangible Assets comprises its purchase price, borrowing cost and any cost directly attributable to bringing the asset to its working condition for its intended use, net charges on foreign exchange contracts and adjustments arising from exchange rate variations attributable to the assets.

5. Depreciation

Depreciation has been charged on all fixed assets under written down value method in accordance with the life specified in Schedule II of the Companies Act, 2013. Depreciation on assets purchased and put to use during the year has been provided on pro rata basis.

6. Inventories

Items of inventories are measured at lower of cost and net realisable value after providing for obsolescence, if any, except in case of by-products which are valued at net realisable value. Cost of inventories comprises of cost of purchase, cost of conversion and other costs including manufacturing overheads incurred in bringing them to their respective present location and condition. Cost of raw materials, process chemicals, stores and spares, packing materials, trading and other products are determined on weighted average basis.



NOTES FORMING PART OF CONSOLIDATED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

7. Provisions, Contingent liabilities and Contingent Assets

Provisions involving substantial degree of estimation in measurement are recognized when there is a present obligation as a result of past events and it is probable that there will be an outflow of resources. Contingent liabilities & Contingent assets are neither recognized nor disclosed in the financial statements.

8. Provision for Current Tax & Deferred Tax

- a) Provision for current tax is made after taking into consideration benefits admissible under the provisions of Income tax Act, 1961.
- b) The company has opted to new tax regime under section 115BAA during the financial year.
- c) Deferred tax resulting from "timing differences" between taxable and accounting income is accounted for using the tax rates and laws that are enacted or substantively enacted as on the balance sheet date. The deferred tax assets is recognized and carried forward only to the extent the management has estimated that there is a reasonable/ virtual certainty that the asset will be realized in future.

9. Related Party Disclosures

As notified in the Companies Rule 2006, the disclosure of transactions with the related party as defined in AS – 18 are disclosed in Notes

10. Cash Flow Statement

Cash flows are reported using the indirect method, whereby profit before tax is adjusted for the effects of transactions of a non-cash nature, any deferrals or accruals of past or future operating cash receipts or payments and item of income or expenses associated with investing or financing cash flows. The cash flows from operating, investing and financing activities of the Company are segregated.

11. Foreign Currency Transaction

- a. Transactions denominated in foreign currencies are recorded at the exchange rate prevailing on the date of the transaction or that approximates the actual rate at the date of the transaction.
- b. Monetary items denominated in foreign currencies at the year end are restated at year end rates.
- c. Any income or expense on account of exchange difference either on settlement or on translation is recognised in the Profit and Loss Statement, except in case of long term liabilities, where they relate to acquisition of Fixed Assets, in which case they are adjusted to the carrying cost of such assets.

12. Investments

Current investments are carried at lower of cost and quoted/fair value, computed category-wise. Non Current investments are stated at cost. Provision for diminution in the value of Non Current investments is made only if such a decline is other than temporary.

13. Income Taxes

Tax expense comprises of current tax and deferred tax. Current tax is measured at the amount expected to be paid to the tax authorities, using the applicable tax rates. Deferred income tax reflect the current period timing differences between taxable income and accounting income for the period and reversal of timing differences of earlier years/period. Deferred tax assets are recognised only to the extent that there is a reasonable certainty that sufficient future income will be available except that deferred tax assets, in case there are unabsorbed depreciation or losses, are recognised if there is virtual certainty that sufficient future taxable income will be available to realise the same.

Deferred tax assets and liabilities are measured using the tax rates and tax law that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the Balance Sheet date.
